Enforcement Requests

How can the community request a camera?

- Email
 - Police_SpeedCameraEnforcement@co.pg.md.us
 - Inbox is monitored by AED staff
- Police Community Meetings
 - Division Commanders and Community Engagement officers receive requests and refer them to the Automated Enforcement Division
- 311
 - Although automated enforcement is not an explicit option, DPW&T reviews 311 requests for traffic-calming and can request or suggest a speed camera as part of a traffic-calming solution

How can the community request a camera?

- Citizen Advisory Committee
 - Once active, this will be a primary source for community requests for speed enforcement cameras, as well as overall feedback on the program in general.

How are requests tracked?

- AED maintains a log of all requests. We record:
 - The requested location
 - The date/time the request was made
 - The type of device requests (speed, red-light)
 - The name, contact info, and organization of the requestor
 - The source of the request (Email, referral, Community Meeting, CAC, etc)
