AN ACT concerning

Temporary Interfund Cash Borrowing

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of Finance to use funds available in the Stormwater Management Enterprise Fund to temporarily fund the Criminal Court Complex, an approved Capital project, pending the future sale of enabled and authorized bonds for this project.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 818 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, and Section 10-182.1 of the Prince George's County Code, the County Council may authorize by legislative act, upon request of the County Executive, temporary inter-fund cash borrowings; and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Court Complex is in need of additional

funding pending the County's next scheduled bond sale; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive deems it desirable to undertake temporary cash borrowing from the Stormwater Management Enterprise Fund for immediate expenditure in order to meet temporary cash requirements for financing the Criminal Court Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds to be borrowed are available and are not necessary to meet payments for any contracts or obligations now in effect; and

WHEREAS, the capital project to be financed has been duly authorized for sale by a bond enabling act CB-69-1986, and a bond authorization act CB-110-1990, both duly adopted and in effect on or before the effective date of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the temporary cash borrowing will be repaid from the first proceeds of the next scheduled bond sale or from other available funds to be designated by the Director of Finance; therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to effect temporary cash borrowings of available funds from the Stormwater Management Enterprise Fund in the amount of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000) for immediate expenditure in order to finance the Criminal Court Complex (CIP# SQ300183).

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the temporary cash borrowing authorized by this Act shall be repaid to the Stormwater Management Enterprise Fund out of the first proceeds of sale of the

general obligation bonds sold pursuant to CB-110-1990 to fund the project for which such borrowing was expended, or from other available funds as determined by the Director of Finance.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the County Council approves the expenditure of funds collected pursuant to Section 21-123 of the Prince George's County Code for the purposes set forth in this Act.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five calendar days after the date it becomes law.
