RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Business License Renewal Late Fee

3 For the purpose of adopting a new late fee of \$100 to renew each expired business license.

4 WHEREAS, late fees are needed to enforce business license renewal requirements as well
5 as ensure those who are conducting business in Prince George’s County; and

6 WHEREAS, late fees for the renewal of business licenses shall be adopted and collected
7 per the fee prescribed in the Table of Fees section 2-253.63, Attachment A and as published on
8 the DPIE website; and

9 WHEREAS, if the application for renewal is pending through no fault of the licensee after
10 the expiration date, then that application will not be subject to administrative late fees; and

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-253.63 of the Prince George’s County Code, the
12 Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (“DPIE”) shall establish and maintain a
13 table of fees for all types of permits and such table shall be published on the DPIE website; and

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-253.63 of the Prince George’s County Code, the
15 Director of DPIE or County Council shall have the authority to change the fees as deemed
16 necessary; and

17 WHEREAS, prior to changing the fees, DPIE must hold a public information session to
18 allow for public comment, must submit the fee changes to the County Executive for approval,
19 and then must submit the fee changes to County Council by Resolution for approval after notice
20 and a public hearing; and

21 WHEREAS, Attachment A Attachment A is the proposed additions to the Table of Fees,
22 section 2-253.63, Attachment A and as published on the DPIE website, Business License

1 Renewal Late Fee, attached hereto and made a part of the record hereof; and

2 WHEREAS, the County Executive reviewed such changes and approved the increase as
3 appropriate and necessary.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
5 County, Maryland, that late fees for the renewal of expired business licenses be adopted and
6 maintained by Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement as described in the Table
7 of Fees set forth in Attachment A attached hereto and made a part of the record hereof is
8 approved as appropriate and necessary.
