

1 WHEREAS, as a direct consequence and result of the President of the United States
2 incitement of the crowd, they unlawfully breached and vandalized the Capitol, injured and killed
3 law enforcement and other personnel, menaced Members of Congress, the Vice President of the
4 United States and Congressional personnel and engaged in other violent and destructive acts; and

5 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Council believes that these acts warrant an
6 appropriate response under the Constitution and laws of the United States in order to protect our
7 democratic principles, the rule of law and the peaceful transfer of power.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
9 County, Maryland, that the County Council condemns the incitement by the President of the
10 United States, Members of Congress and others to undermine our democratic institutions,
11 process, and acts of violence against the United States Capitol and the United States Congress,
12 the lack of action to protect the representatives and citizens of the United States and the loss of
13 life caused by the violent actions and failures on January 6, 2021.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George’s County Council calls upon the
15 President, the Cabinet, the United States Congress and/or Federal and local enforcement agencies
16 to take the following actions: (1) to seek the condemnation and removal of the President of the
17 United States by resignation or other constitutional means; (2) that Members of Congress also
18 involved be censured or otherwise reprimanded for their unlawful conduct contrary to their oath
19 of office; (3) seek the apprehension, arrest and full prosecution of those responsible and involved
20 in the violence and destruction of the United States Capitol and (4) to appropriately plan and
21 provide law enforcement protection for the January 20, 2021 Inauguration of the 46th President
22 of the United States and for the days leading up thereto.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Prince George’s County Council that the Clerk of
24 the Council forward a copy of this Resolution to the Speaker of the United States House of
25 Representatives, the Majority Leader of the United States Senate, and the entire Maryland
26 Congressional delegation.
