RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Contract Approvals

3 For the purpose of approving certain multiyear contracts in accordance with the Prince George's
4 County Charter and Subtitle 10 of the Prince George's County Code.

5 WHEREAS, Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, requires
6 that the County Council approve, by Resolution, multiyear contracts exceeding an aggregate of
7 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for goods and services, as well as all multiyear
8 personal service contracts exceeding an aggregate of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000)
9 per contractor; and

10 WHEREAS, via its enactment of Council Bill No. 033-2016 on July 19, 2016, the County
11 Council approved certain codified procedural requirements in furtherance of compliance with
12 Section 819 of the County Charter; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to CB-033-2016, Section 10-105 of the Prince George's County
14 Code requires that the County Executive submit, on a yearly basis, a report listing all executory
15 multiyear personal service contracts for the ensuing fiscal year exceeding an aggregate of One
16 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) per contractor, and all other executory multiyear
17 contracts for the ensuing fiscal year exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
18 (\$500,000) for public review, comment, and approval action by the County Council; and

19 WHEREAS, the Council reviewed the report of executory multiyear contracts submitted by
20 the County Executive, set forth in Attachment A and incorporated as if set forth fully herein (the
21 "Report"); and

22 WHEREAS, the Council finds that, based on its review of Attachment A, an action to

1 approve the executory multiyear contracts within the submitted report is required in accordance
2 with the prescriptions of County law and to ratify any contracts listed on the Report that were
3 executed to date; and

4 WHEREAS, the Council further finds that the approval of such multiyear contracts
5 necessitating Council action is plainly in the public interest.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
7 County, Maryland, that the proposed executory multiyear contracts requiring approval of the
8 County Council, submitted by the County Executive pursuant to Section 819 and Subtitle 10 of
9 the Prince George's County Code and described as set forth in Attachment A hereto, be and the
10 same are hereby APPROVED.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make
12 such necessary modifications, adjustments, corrections, or any other changes as may be
13 necessary, to finalize the subject agreements in any manner the County Executive may deem
14 necessary or proper but not altering its substance.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution requires a public hearing; the Clerk of
16 the County Council shall be directed to set and give notice of a public hearing on this Resolution
17 in accordance with prescriptions of law.
