For the purpose of amending certain revenues and expenditures in the Approved Maryland-				
National Capital Park and Planning Commission's Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2011.				
WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2011 for the				
Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission was adopted by CB-43-2010; and				
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board, by letter dated September 7,				
2011, requested that certain portions of this budget be amended; and				
WHEREAS, under the provisions of Article 28, Annotated Code of Maryland, Section 2-				
118(a)(6), the b	udget may be amended by resolution by the respective County Council on their			
initiative or at the request of the Commission after receipt of recommendations of the respective				
county executiv	re; and			
WHEREAS, the Merit System Board's total budget appropriation of \$47,650 per County,				
provided through the Administration Fund Tax, is below estimated expenditures for FY11; and				
WHEREAS, the Merit System Board FY11 proposed budget was reduced significantly and				
the Board was still required to address cases from FY10 and to hear a number of appeals cases				
originating in the current fiscal year; and				
WHEREAS, the Merit System Board requires a FY11 budget increase in the amount of				
\$10,000 in each County; and				
WHEREAS, the source of funds for this increase would be transfers from the Central				
Administrative Services (CAS) Department of Human Resources and Management by reducing				

the department's FY11 budget appropriation level by \$10,000 in Prince George's County; and
