Sec. 2-115.01. S	Statement of Policy.
It is declare	ed to be the public policy of Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County")
	ect and protect all of the County's senior citizens through County policies and
County laws. Se	enior citizens are valued citizens and residents of the County including those

senior citizens who are in need of financial assistance. There exists within the County senior
citizens who are in need of assistance with living expenses. In order to assist senior citizens of
the County who are the head of household and County residents, it is necessary that the County
provide funding to make payment to eligible residents who are 65 years of age and older.
Sec. 2-115.02. Senior Assistance Program.
(a) There is hereby established a Senior Assistance Program. The Senior Assistance
Program shall be administered by the Department of Family Services.
(b) Subject to appropriation, each fiscal year, funds in the County General Fund shall be
made available to financially support senior citizens of the County. Senior Assistance Program
funds shall be identified as Non-Departmental funds by the Office of Management and Budget.
(c) Each fiscal year, subject to appropriation, the Office of Management and Budget shall
identify County General Funds in the Non-Departmental portion of the County Budget to
provide funding for the Senior Assistance Program.
Sec. 2-115.03. Definitions.
As used in this Division:
(a) County shall mean Prince George's County, Maryland.
(b) Head of Household means the person that holds the deed, title or lease on a property,
it is their main residence and they are legally responsible for the rent or mortgage.
(c) Household Income is identified as all combined gross household income before
deductions. This includes income from all sources including Social Security as well as all other
retirement benefits.
(d) Resident means a person who is a legal resident of the United States and has been a
County resident for at least one year.
(e) Senior Citizen means a person who is 65 years of age and older.
Sec. 2-115.04. Eligibility.
To be deemed eligible for the Senior Assistance Program, a person shall meet the following
<u>criteria:</u>
(a) Be 65 years of age or older;
(b) Have a household income of less than \$35,000 per year;
(c) Be a legal United States resident; and
(d) Be a resident of Prince George's County Maryland for at least one year
