

pending the resolution of concerns raised by Council Member Wineland regarding the alignment of Old Fort Road along the frontage of this site. The preliminary plan is on the Planning Board's agenda on 4/9/92, where these issues will be discussed.

Applicant #91/P-013 (National Church of God) requested a category change from 5 to 4C. The County Executive recommended 4C despite the fact that no preliminary plan of subdivision has been filed, which is a requirement for category 4C. The Committee voted to approve the Planning Board's recommendation of category 4, which will require the applicant to apply for 4C in the next cycle of amendments. It is possible for the full Council to reconsider this recommendation prior to the adoption of CR-14-1992 if the applicant meets the requirements for category 4C at that time.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The County's Comprehensive Ten Year Water and Sewerage Plan provides for three cycles of category change requests to amend the Plan. This resolution represents the December Cycle of Amendments.

The 1988 Ten Year Water and Sewerage Plan was adopted by CR-17-1988, and amended by CR-12-1988, CR-67-1988, CR-103-1988, CR-27-1989, CR-60-1989, CR-84-1989, CR-102-1989, CR-14-1990, CR-45-1990, CR-53-1990, CR-61-1990, CR-67-1990, CR-84-1990, CR-11-1990, CR-44-1991, CR-53-1991, CR-86-1991 and CR-90-1991. The December Cycle of Amendments contains eighteen requests for a category change. Three of the category change requests are in the Blue Plains WWTP basin, one in the

Parkway basin, five in the Western Branch basin, eight in the Piscataway basin, and one in the Mattawoman basin.

Environmental Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5 sets procedures for amendments and revisions to the Plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing on the amendments, the County Council must submit to the WSSC and M-NCPPC a copy of the proposed resolution for their recommendations.
