1 AN ACT concerning

2 Maryland Emergency Management Assistance Compact

3 For the purpose of adopting the Maryland Emergency Management Assistance Compact, Section  
4 14-803 of the Public Safety Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

5 BY adding:

6 SUBTITLE 6. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

7 Section 6-110A,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (2003 Edition, 2006 Supplement).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
11 Maryland, that Section 6-110A of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby  
12 added:

13 **SUBTITLE 6. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.**

14 **DIVISION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

15 **Sec. 6-110A. Maryland Emergency Management Assistance Compact.**

16 The County adopts the Maryland Emergency Management Assistance Compact as set forth  
17 in Section 14-803 of the Public Safety Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as it may be  
18 amended from time to time.

19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
20 calendar days after it becomes law.
