BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

Currently, public uses are permitted uses in all zones if the specific location of the proposed project is identified in the Capital Improvement Program. The proposed ordinance identifies and defines specific public uses that are industrial in nature and regulates those industrial uses in the residential zones. The proposed ordinance also provides for the preservation of the R-O-S Zone by prohibiting certain industrial uses regardless of whether such uses are constructed by or for governmental entities.
