BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This Bill is submitted pursuant to Section 903 of Article IX of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125 (a) of the County Code. The legislation proposes to amend the Public Safety Emergency Call Taker III, and the Public Safety Communications Operations Supervisor as a grade covered by the Police Civilian Employees Association ("PCEA"). Additionally, this legislation corrects the Weapons Instructor Supervisor grade from a G24 to G27.
