



The most effective and fairest tool for regulating growth is to apply the correct zones to county properties.








- "Right size" zoning for properties in specific areas of the county.



#### Managing Growth -Fiscal Impact **Analysis**







- **Expected to begin Summer 2024**
- Develop an understanding of how different types of real estate development, affect tax revenues and public service costs.
- Is the current APFO fairly accounting for impacts associated with new development?
- What are the fiscal impacts related to development?
- Are the revenues generated by development sufficient to cover the operating and capital improvement costs for services provided by the County?
- Consider re-evaluating adequate public facility requirements
- Encourage further policy discussion on smart growth?
