REPORT: Favorable 5-0: Council Members Burroughs, Oriadha, Fisher, Harrison and Ivey.

The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on June 22, 2023, to consider CR-022-2023. CR-022-2023 is an act concerning Military Leave providing for the continuation of the benefits for Prince George's County employees called to active duty in the National Guard of the United States or Reserves as a result of the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, the resultant war on terrorism, and other military actions.

The Office of Law reports CR-022-2023 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Policy Group reports that the enactment of CR-022-2023 would have a positive direct fiscal impact in the form of the collection of franchise fees.

After a discussion that included technical amendments, the Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee reported CR-022-2023 out favorably 5-0.
