SECTION 1. BE IT EN	ACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, that the following	amendment to Section 307A, Charter of Prince George's County,
Maryland, is hereby proposed	:
Sec. 307A. Term Limitation	1.
[No person shall be eligi	ble to serve more than two consecutive terms on the County
Council.] No person shall be	eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms as County
Executive. This Section shall	apply to [all persons] any person who [are] is currently serving [on
the County Council or] as Co	unty Executive on the effective date of this Section and to all
persons elected thereafter.	
SECTION 2. BE IT FU	RTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act shall be transmitted to
the County Executive for pub	lication, and a copy shall also be transmitted to the Board of
Supervisors of Elections for s	ubmission of the proposed Charter Amendment to the voters of the
County at the 2000 General F	lection pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election occurring on November 7, 2000, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:

## PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

To change part of Section 307A of the Charter of Prince George's County, to allow members of the County Council to serve more than two consecutive terms.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that, if the majority of the votes cast for and against this proposed Charter Amendment at the General Election on November 7, 2000, are in favor of the question, and if the majority of the votes cast for and against the Charter Amendment proposed by CB-70-2000, providing for the elimination of term limitations for the County Executive, are in favor of the question, then both Charter Amendments shall be effective and provisions of Section 307A of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, shall be deemed repealed in their entirety.

Adopted this <u>25th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 2000, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full County Council.
