1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The 2001 Water and Sewer Plan (August 2002 Cycle of Amendments)

3 For the purpose of approving the withdrawal of water in accordance with the 2001 Water and
4 Sewer Plan.5 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
6 Maryland requires the County to adopt a comprehensive plan dealing with water supply and
7 sewerage systems, establishes the procedures governing the preparation and adoption of said
8 plan, and provides for amendments and revisions thereto; and9 WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public hearing
10 on the particular application identified in Attachments A and B; and11 WHEREAS, the County Council notified the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission,
12 the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the State and County Health
13 Departments, the Maryland Department of Planning and the Maryland Department of the
14 Environment of the public hearing and provided each agency with copies of the particular
15 application identified in Attachments A and B.16 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
17 George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County 2001 Water and Sewer Plan, as
18 adopted by CR-62-2001, and amended by CR-9-2002 and CR-36-2002, is further amended by
19 approving the withdrawal of water as shown in Attachment A, attached hereto and made a part
20 hereof.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maps identified as the “Prince George’s
2 County, Maryland, 2001 Water Category Map” and “Prince George’s County, Maryland, 2001
3 Sewer Category Map”, are hereby amended to incorporate the approved withdrawal of water for
4 the property locations delineated on the maps in Attachment B, attached hereto and made a part
5 hereof.

6 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five working days of the adoption
7 of this resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council.

8 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on the
9 day following the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County
10 Executive transmits his comments on the resolution, or on the day that the County Executive
11 indicates he has no comments, or ten working days following the transmittal of this resolution to
12 the County Executive, whichever shall occur first. Prior to the effective date of this resolution,
13 the Council may reconsider its action based upon any recommendation received from the County
14 Executive.

15 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this resolution,
16 it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland Department
17 of the Environment.
