BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Secondhand and Pawn Dealers

3 For the purpose of providing hours of operation for licensed dealers and prohibiting the use of
4 drive-up windows and similar services.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.

7 Section 5-240,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (1999 Edition).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 5-240 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.

14 DIVISION 19. SECONDHAND AND PAWN DEALERS.

15 **Sec. 5-240. [Police Department] Regulations.**

16 (a) The Chief of Police of the County Police Department is authorized to issue regulations
17 to implement this Division.

18 (b) A pawn dealer or a second hand dealer may be open to the public between the hours of
19 7:00 a. m. and 10:00 p. m. and shall not conduct any business with the public at any other time.

20 (c) The use of a drive-up window or other practice, service or device that enables a patron
21 to conduct business from a motor vehicle without leaving the motor vehicle is prohibited.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
2 calendar days after it becomes law.
