(i)[(h)] The failure of a contract to comply with the requirements of Subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), [and] (g), and (h) shall enable a party to the contract who is aggrieved by such failure to rescind the contract at any time prior to settlement. The right of rescission provided by this Subsection is not an exclusive remedy, and any other right or cause of action available to a party to the sales contract shall remain.

- j[(i)] No contract for the sale of real property located in the County shall contain any statement in violation of Sections 29-124 and 29-125.
- $\underline{k}[(j)]$  Notwithstanding any other provision of this Division, the jurisdiction of the Department of the Environment shall not extend to this Subdivision except for the purpose of assisting in consumer education and information as to the requirements of this Section.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
