RE: FY 2023 Board of Education Approved Operating Budget Transmittal

Dear County Executive Alsobrooks and Chair Hawkins:

Pursuant to the Education Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Board of Education herewith submits its FY 2023 Approved Annual Operating Budget.

On June 23, 2022, the Board of Education adopted this balanced budget for both revenue and expenditures totaling \$2,659,688,770 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. The overall goal of the FY 2023 Operating Budget is to continue to support critical school-based initiatives through equity and innovation while improving negotiated labor agreements and maintaining fiscal responsibility. While the implementation of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future legislation will increase State and required County revenues over the next decade, that increase was tempered for FY 2023 by declines in the official enrollment counts.

Following the final FY 2023 reconciliation, the categorical totals adopted by the Board of Education differ from those adopted by the County Council. These differences are primarily due to additional grants awarded and anticipated after the FY2023 Requested Budget was approved, as well as the additional use of Fund Balance to cover the financial enhancements in the agreements negotiated with all of our labor partners. The Board of Education resolution adopting the FY 2023 Operating Budget is attached for your reference.

We respectfully request approval of the outlined reconciling adjustments between major categories in order to align the County Council's Approved Budget with the Board of Education's Approved Budget.
