WHEREAS	S, CB-51-2002 is an ordinance defining and adopting land use regulations for	
Aviation Policy Areas and providing for the designation of such Aviation Policy Areas adjacent		
to general aviation	on airports in Prince George's County, Maryland; and	
WHEREAS, development is restricted in certain of the Aviation Policy Areas and regulated		
in other of the A	viation Policy Areas; and	
WHEREAS, the Fairwood development is located adjacent to Freeway Airport (a general		
aviation airport) and a portion of the Fairwood property previously proposed for development		
will be impacted	by Aviation Policy Areas; and	
WHEREAS	S, CB-51-2002 allows for the relocation of residential dwelling units to other	
locations within a property impacted by an Aviation Policy Area; and		
WHEREAS, the approved Preliminary Development Plan (A-9894-C) and the approved		
Comprehensive S	Sketch Plan for Phase II (CP-0101) for Fairwood both show a proposed	
interchange and a right-of-way for a transportation facility known commonly as A-44 potentially		

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impacting developable areas of Fairwood; and

WHEREAS, the County Council is desirous that the land area designated as the proposed A-44 facility on the Fairwood Property be available for relocation of residential dwelling units and that the Planning Board not require either dedication or reservation of the proposed A-44 transportation facility at the time that property is the subject of a preliminary plan of subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland supports the development and construction of residential dwelling units within the Fairwood Community on that portion of the Fairwood Property designated as being impacted by the A-44 interchange and right-of-way; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, also recommends that the area on the Fairwood Property designated as being impacted by the proposed interchange and right-of-way for the A-44 facility not be required for dedication or placed in reservation at the time the preliminary subdivision plan for that portion of the Fairwood Property is approved.
