Section 15-103 of the Land Use Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires that Prince George's County provide a reasonable geographic balance with respect to all Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission appointments. This Resolution addresses the geographic distribution and balance of the membership of the Maryland-National Park and Planning Commission and confirms Gloria Gary Lawlah to serve as a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission of the Prince George's County Planning Board.
