This legislation was introduced on October 6, 2009. The committee discussed this legislation in conjunction with CB-54-2009 and CB-55-2009 at four meetings held on October 21st, November 2nd, November 4th, and November 13th.

Chad Williams, Project Leader in the Prince George's County Planning Department, was present at all meetings to provide background and to respond to questions on the new mixed use zoning tool as proposed in the above-mentioned Council Bills.

The committee took no action on CB-52-2009. A public hearing is scheduled on this legislation on November 17, 2009.

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## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

The proposed legislation amends the Subdivision Regulations to define relationships between Subdivision and Subtitle 27A. The bill also adds regulations under the Subdivision jurisdiction, resubdivision of land, informational mailings with applications for major subdivisions, private roads, and easements sections to provide standards for property that is located within an Urban Center zone and subject to an approved Regulating Plan.
