This Council Bill was presented by Council Member Fisher and referred to the Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy and Environment Committee.

AFFECTED CODE SECTIONS:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill strengthens enforcement against illegal vending on sidewalks and within the public right-of-way in Prince George's County by updating the County's vending rules. This bill increases penalties for unlawful roadside/right-of-way sales, including escalating fines for repeat offenses, and clarifies that violations can result in the immediate removal of goods and equipment.
