Committee Vote: Favorable, 7-0 (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Campos, Lehman, Olson, Patterson, Toles and Turner. Absent: Council Members Davis and Harrison)

Staff gave an overview of the purpose of the resolution. CR-20-2014 provides for a transfer of certain appropriations and expenditures between certain programs in the FY2013-14 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund. The proposed adjustments include a decrease in the amount of \$10,000 from the Suitland Boys and Girls Club project and an increase in the same amount to the White Rose Foundation project.

Council Member Toles informed the Council that the funding will still be utilized for youth activities in the same community as the original project charge. M-NCPPC Parks and Recreation Department staff members were present to respond to Council Members' questions. A representative of the White Rose Foundation was also present.
