**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Revenue Authority

3 For the purpose of revising the composition of the membership of the Revenue Authority.

4 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

5 SUBTITLE 21A. REVENUE AUTHORITY.

6 Section 21A-115,

7 The Prince George's County Code

8 (1999 Edition, 2002 Supplement).

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
 10 Maryland, that Section 21A-115 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby  
 11 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

12 SUBTITLE 21A. REVENUE AUTHORITY.

13 DIVISION 2. REVENUE AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED.

14 **Sec. 21A-115. Membership.**

15 (a) The Authority shall consist of [five (5)] seven public members and two [(2)] ex officio  
 16 members. All shall be voting members. The ex officio members shall be the Chief  
 17 Administrative Officer of the County or a Deputy Chief Administrative Officer, as designated by  
 18 the County Executive, and the Director of the Office of Management and Budget.

19 (b) All members shall be persons who possess ability, experience, and integrity.

20 (c) Five of the [The] public members shall be appointed by the County Executive for terms  
 21 of four [(4)] years each and confirmed by the County Council. Two of the public members shall

1 be appointed by the County Council according to the Council's rules. The terms of the  
2 appointments shall be staggered in such a manner that the terms of office of no more than two  
3 [(2)] members of the Authority may expire in the same year.

4 (d) Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term in the manner of original appointment.  
5 Each member shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified even though the period of  
6 service may extend beyond the four [(4)] year term. All official acts and votes of any member  
7 during the period of extended service shall be valid as if the member were within said four [(4)]  
8 year term. A member of the Authority may be removed by the County Executive for cause.

9 (e) Two of the public members shall be designated by the County Executive to serve as  
10 Chairman and Vice Chairman. Each such officer shall serve until a successor is designated even  
11 though the period of service may extend beyond the period originally designated by the County  
12 Executive. All official acts of any such officer during the period of extended office shall be valid  
13 as if the officer were within the period of original designation.

14 (f) The public members shall be entitled to such compensation as is established in the  
15 annual operating budget of the Authority, provided that such compensation shall be paid only for  
16 meetings actually attended.

1       SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
2 calendar days after it becomes law.
