Maryland Impact





- UMGC offers the second-lowest in-state tuition and fees among all four-year Maryland public institutions
- UMGC confers 33% of all degrees granted by institutions in the University System of Maryland
- UMGC has partnerships with all Maryland community colleges and ranks #1 in enrolling community college transfer students
- UMGC ranks #1 in Maryland in conferring cybersecurity and information technology degrees (including for women and students of color)

- Laurel College Center (hybrid classrooms & onsite advising)
- Prince George's Community College (onsite advising)



Joint Base Andrews (JBA)

- UMGC has had classroom and service locations at JBA since 1972; it
 is one of UMGC's longest-established military sites and is the second
 largest in headcounts and enrollments worldwide
- In FY22, 1,682 students took UMGC courses at JBA; 60% of students were active-duty military, 28% were veterans, and 12% were civilians
- Onsite resources include student advising, four hybrid classrooms, a computer lab, and a National Testing Center.
- UMGC offers courses each semester in a variety of programs including business administration, criminal justice, information systems, cybersecurity, and management studies

Partnerships in Prince George's County

- Prince George's County Government UMGC maintains an alliance agreement to provide a tuition discount to county employees and family members
- Prince George's Community College one of UMGC's largest transfer partners.
- College Park Academy & CPA@Home developing articulation and dual enrollment pathway
- Summer Youth Enrichment Program UMGC offers up to 10 County young adults an enriching and constructive summer work experience almost every year since 2015

Maryland Completion Scholarship

Eligible Maryland community college graduates can complete a bachelor's degree at UMGC for \$12,000 or less, well below the typical cost of in-state tuition.

Since spring 2014, more than 13,400 of these scholarships have been awarded and 6,230 recipients have completed a UMGC credential.

The 3D Scholars Program was created to offer a pathway for Prince George's County students to earn an affordable bachelor's degree at a significantly reduced cost.

The name "3D" stands for the three degrees earned in the program:

- High school diploma (Prince George's County Public Schools)
- Associate degree (Prince George's County Community College)
- Bachelor's degree (UMGC: BS in Business Administration, BS in Criminal Justice, or BS in Cybersecurity Technology)

As of this fall, 100+ students are enrolled in the program (11th graders and 12th graders at Flowers High School, PGCC enrollees, UMGC enrollees) and 90 additional students are in the pipeline to enter the program.
