BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of eliminating and adding certain classes of work and establishing a new Y
 4 Salary Schedule to the bargaining unit represented by the International Association of Fire
 5 Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619.

6 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 7 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code has, in order to
 8 provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
 9 Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to certain classes of work described
 10 within Section 1 of this Bill; and pursuant to the collective bargaining agreement between Prince
 11 George's County and the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 now,
 12 therefore,
