WHEREAS	S, the County Council desires to study the issues pertaining specifically to
common owners	hip communities and consider appropriate recommendations relating thereto;

WHEREAS	S, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council or the County Executive
may appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the	
County who shall	ll assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.
NOW, THI	EREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
County, Marylar	nd, that a temporary advisory board is hereby created for the purpose of
evaluating and advising the County on issues relating to common ownership communities, which	
shall be known a	s the Common Ownership Communities Task Force.
BE IT FUR	THER RESOLVED that the task force membership shall be composed of
twenty (21) men	nbers:
1. A Cha	irperson who shall be selected by the County Council;
2. Nine (9) residents of self-managed and professionally managed common ownership
communities, inc	cluding condominiums, cooperative and homeowner associations;

Three (3) representatives from the real estate sales and development communities;
