PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

Date: 6/5/97

Committee Report: Favorable as amended, 3-0, (In favor: Council Members Wilson, Maloney and Scott).

This bill will adopt the County's 1997 Inventory of Real Property and Improvement. Section 2.111.01 of the County Code requires the County Executive to present an inventory of all real property and improvements to the Council no later than the first day of May of each year for adoption by legislative act. Only the properties contained in the adopted inventory are permitted to be proposed for lease, sale or disposal.

The original list of inventory of County property contained a number of properties which were no longer under County ownership and therefore should not have appeared in the inventory. Draft 2 has deleted these properties from the County inventory.

The inventory consists of the following:

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-64-1997.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

For the purpose of adopting the 1997 Inventory of Real Property and Improvements titled in the name of Prince George's County.
