RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan

3 For the purpose of adopting the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan and the 2018 Water and
4 Sewer Category Maps, revising the fee schedule for administering Water and Sewer Plan
5 amendments, and the purchase of maps and related materials.

6 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
7 Maryland requires the County to adopt a comprehensive plan dealing with water supply
8 and sewerage systems, establishes the procedures governing the preparation and adoption
9 of said plan, and provides for amendments and revisions thereto; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to said procedures, the County Executive submitted to the
11 County Council her recommendations on the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan; and

12 WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public
13 hearing on the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Council notified the Washington Suburban Sanitary
15 Commission, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the State
16 and County Health Departments, the Maryland Department of Planning and the Maryland
17 Department of the Environment of the public hearing and provided each agency with
18 copies of the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan.

19 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of
20 Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County 2008 Water and
21 Sewer Plan, as adopted by CR-91-2008, and amended by CR-17-2009, CR-52-2009, CR-
22 5-2010, CR-19-2010,

1 CR-82-2010, CR-20-2011, CR-4-2012, CR-19-2012, CR-27-2012, CR-71-2012, CR-20-
2 2013, CR-50-2013, CR-92-2013, CR-11-2014, CR-57-2014, CR-16-2015, CR-45-2015,
3 CR-43-2016, CR-62-2016, CR-23-2017, CR-58-2017, CR-03-2018, CR-06-2018, CR-34-
4 2018, CR-018-2019, and CR-044-2019 is hereby amended and replaced by the 2018
5 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Attachment A, attached hereto and made a part
6 hereof.

7 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maps identified as the “Prince
8 George’s County, Maryland, 2008 Water Map” and “Prince George’s County, Maryland,
9 2008 Sewer Map”, are hereby amended and replaced by the “Prince George’s County,
10 Maryland, 2018 Water Map” and “Prince George’s County, Maryland 2018 Sewer Map”
11 located in Appendices C and D of the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in
12 Attachment A, attached hereto and made a part thereof.

13 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fee Schedule is hereby
14 adopted as shown in Appendix 6-2 of the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in
15 Attachment A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

16 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive and the
17 County Council shall determine that all proposed amendments to the Plan are in
18 accordance with the Category Change Policies and Criteria as adopted in Section 2.1.4 of
19 the 2018 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Attachment A, attached hereto and made a
20 part hereof; and, any application may be rejected if the policies and criteria are not met.

21 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Resolution
22 are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection,
23 paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Resolution is declared
24 invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or
25 unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences,
26 subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Resolution, since the same
27 would have been adopted without the incorporation in this Resolution of any such invalid
28 or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
29 or section.

30 SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five working days of the
31 adoption of this Resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk

1 of the Council.

2 SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect
3 on the day following the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after
4 the County Executive transmits her comments on the Resolution, or on the day that the
5 County Executive indicates she has no comments, or ten working days following the
6 transmittal of this Resolution to the County Executive, whichever shall occur first. Prior
7 to the effective date of this Resolution, the Council may reconsider its action based upon
8 any recommendation received from the County Executive.

9 SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this
10 Resolution, it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the
11 Maryland Department of the Environment.
