SUBDIVISION BILL

1 AN ACT concerning
2 Subdivision Regulations, Minor and Major Subdivisions or Resubdivision Applicability
3 For the purpose of exempting qualified data centers from filing preliminary plans of subdivision
4 and establishing requirements for public notice and adequate public facilities.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 24-3402(b)(4) of the Prince George's County Code is repealed and
12 reenacted with the following amendments:

21 **(4) Exemptions from Filing Preliminary Plans**

1 The following do not require approval of a preliminary plan but may instead be
2 submitted to the Planning Director and reviewed as a final plat for minor subdivision for which no
3 preliminary plan is required.

5 (I) Any subdivision for land used primarily for a qualified data center, is subject
6 to the following additional requirements:

7 (i) Notwithstanding Section 24-3303(b)(2) of these Regulations, an
8 applicant for a final plat for the subdivision of land proposed to be used primarily for a qualified
9 data center is required to conduct a pre-application neighborhood meeting in accordance with
10 Section 24-3303, Pre-Application Neighborhood Meeting, and

11 (ii) A certificate of adequacy has been approved in accordance with
12 Section 24-4500, Public Facility Adequacy.

14 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
15 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
16 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
17 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
18 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
19 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
20 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
21 or section.

22 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect thirty (30)
23 calendar days after it becomes law.
