RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Military Leave

For the purpose of amending the Salary Plan of the County to reflect the addition of certain Military Leave Benefits.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 903 of Article IX of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of the Prince George's County Code, amendments to the County's Salary Plan are to be submitted to the County Council in resolution form; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended that the Salary Plan be amended to reflect the addition of certain military leave benefits; and

WHEREAS, Section 1017 of the Charter provides that a resolution has the force and effect of law of a temporary or administrative character;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby approves the following amendment to all Salary Schedules of the Salary Plan of the County, submitted and recommended by the County Executive on January 18, 2002:

Add the following language to each salary schedule:

“ Any employee called to active military service in response to the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, shall be eligible for the benefits set forth herein:

Participation in a Countywide leave bank whereby other County employees may donate annual or compensatory leave for use by an activated employee after all of the activated employee’s annual, personal and compensatory leave has been exhausted.

1 Eligibility for health care benefits is to continue once the activated employee enters a leave
2 without pay status with both the employer and employee contributions being paid by the County
3 for up to one year.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a temporary Special Leave Bank is hereby established
5 whereby County employees may donate annual or compensatory leave for use by any employee
6 of the County called to active military service in response to the terrorist attacks on
7 September 11, 2001.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the benefits provided by this Resolution shall expire
9 one calendar year from the date of its adoption.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other provisions of the Salary Schedules previously
11 approved and adopted remain unchanged.
