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**REPORT:** Favorable 4-0 (In Favor: Council Members Davis, Lehman, Patterson, and Turner; Absent: Taveras)

CR-59-2018 amends the salary plan for civilian employees who are members within the Prince George's County Police Civilian Employees Association to reflect wage and benefit modifications effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020.

The major modifications included in CR-59-2018 are included in the Settlement Summary attached to the Transmittal letter and they are included in the Committee Report for CB-78-2018, the Bill which approves the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

During the Committee meeting Joe Adler, Labor Negotiator, Office of Human Resources Management, provided the Committee an overview of CR-59-2018.

The Office of Law finds CR-59-2018 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reports that CR-59-2018 will have a negative impact on the County of \$1,209,804 for FY19 and FY20.

After discussion, the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee voted CR-59-2018 out favorably 4-0.
