**REPORT:** Committee Vote: Favorable, 8-0 (In favor: Chair Ivey, Council Members Blegay, Burroughs, Dernoga, Hawkins, Olson, Oriadha, and Watson)

The County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on September 24, 2024, to discuss CB-070-2024, a bill concerning the Prince George's Subdivision Regulations (2023 Edition). Pursuant to Section 321 of the Charter, the Council is required, at intervals not greater than every four years, to compile and codify all laws of the County in effect at such time. The Subdivision Regulations shall also include an index and such appropriate notes, citations, annotations, and appendices as the Council may determine. The most recent edition of the Subdivision Regulations is the 2019 Edition. The bill will adopt the 2023 Edition of the Prince George's Subdivision Regulations.

The Office of Law found the bill to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to enactment.

The County Executive's Office supports the enactment of CB-070-2024.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted favorably on CB-070-2024.
