Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-2 (In favor: Council Members Gourdine, Maloney and Russell; Opposed: Estepp and Del Giudice).

This resolution amends the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule "P-O" for Police Officials. Also, this resolution will implement similar economic modifications for Police Officials at the rank of Captain and Major contained in the Collective Bargaining Agreement for Police officers through the rank of Lieutenant.

HIGHLIGHT OF THE SALARY PLAN:

- 1. No COLA or Merit increases.
- 2. Reduced Holiday Pay by 2/3. (pp5, Section VII)
- 3. Annual Leave Carryover and Unused Annual and Sick Leave Payment amended to comply with CB-62-1995. (pp 7, Section C & D)
- 4. Discretionary Leave. (pp 8-G)
- 5. Contribution to Retirement Trust Fund. (pp 9, Section XI)
- 6. Clothing Allowance in the amount of \$925 for FY96.

The fiscal impact on the County will be positive in the amount of approximately \$37,700.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The County Council is considering legislation for enactment to implement the provisions of the recently negotiated collective bargaining agreement for officers through the rank of Lieutenant.
