AN ACT concerning

Pet Licenses

FOR the purpose of increasing the age at which a dog or cat must be licensed.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 3. ANIMAL CONTROL.

Sections 3-145, and

3-147,

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 3-145 and 3-147 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby repealed and

reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 3. ANIMAL CONTROL.

DIVISION 5. LICENSES AND STANDARDS.

Subdivision 1. Pet Licenses.

Sec. 3-145. Dog and cat licenses.

(a) A dog or cat which is [four (4)] six (6) months of age or older shall be licensed by the owner as herein provided.

* * * * *

Sec. 3-147. Same: time to apply; renewal; penalty.

(a) An owner shall apply for a license within ten (10) days after a dog or cat becomes [four (4)] six (6) months of age.

* * * * *

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
