(b) First Reading of Bills (Presentation)

<u>CB-11-2012 – (EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 7 -2012) REORGANIZATIONAL</u> <u>PROPOSAL</u> relating to the Fire Commission.

On February 24, 2012, the County Executive transmitted Executive Order No. 7-2012 proposing a Reorganization of the Fire Commission. Pursuant to Charter Section 503, this Reorganization will become effective on April 24, 2012 unless disapproved by a majority vote of the full Council prior to that date. Council Bill 11 was presented by the Chair, by request of the County Executive and referred to the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee.

Correspondence was proposed to be sent to the Members of the Prince George's County Senate and House Delegations, expressing the Prince George's County Council's opposition to the proposed Teacher Pension Shift. Todd Turner, Legislative Officer, provided an overview of the contents of the letter and provided a brief review of efforts on the issue noting dates and times of upcoming Public Hearing in the State Legislature.
