**REPORT:** Committee Vote: Favorable with amendments 4-0 (Council Members Watson, Burroughs, Oriadha, and Dernoga)

The Prince George's County Council Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on March 13 and on June 10, 2025, to consider **CR-050-2025**, a Resolution concerning Compensation and Benefits for General Schedule Employees—Salary Schedule G.

During the meeting, Council staff noted that the legislation would amend the County's Salary Plan to reflect modified pay rates for General Schedule Employees. The legislation makes provision for a two percent (2%) Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) effective April 6, 2025.

Adoption of CR-050-2025 is estimated to have a total adverse fiscal impact on the County for Fiscal Year 2025 of approximately \$1,363,711 due to cost-of-living adjustments. The amount is lower than previous fiscal years due to the proposed resolution not taking effect until April 6, 2025.

Ms. Sakinda Skinner, County Council Liaison with the County Executive's Office, and Ms. Gitana Stewart-Ponder, Acting Director of the Office of Human Resources Management, requested the committee's support.

After further discussion, Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee voted favorably 4-0.
