The Legislative Officer provided a summary of the bill and referral comments that were received. CB-37-2009 authorizes the County to utilize speed monitoring systems pursuant to Section 21-809 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. Representatives from the Police Department, The Revenue Authority and provided additional information to the Committee.

The Office of Law determined that CB-37-2009 was in proper legislative form.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there may be a positive fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CB-37-2009.
