The County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, having fully considered the <u>amendment to the</u> labor agreement concluded between Prince George's County and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Local 3279, on January 14, 1998, hereby approves said agreement <u>and the amendment thereto in accordance</u> with the provisions of Section 13A-109 of the Prince George's County Code.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and that the Agreement shall be retroactively effective to July 1, 1998.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between Prince George's County, Maryland (the County) and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Local 3279 (the Union). The purpose of this Memorandum is to amend the parties' collective bargaining agreement (the Agreement) covering the period from July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1999.

Specifically, the parties agree that the Agreement is modified by this Memorandum as follows:

Section A. of ARTICLE 12 (WAGES) is modified to read as follows:

A. Employees covered by this Agreement will receive a one-time, lump-sum bonus payment of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) on the second pay date in December, 1997.

Employees covered by this Agreement will receive a two and seventy-five one-hundredths of one percent (2.75%) increase to their base wages effective the first full pay period beginning on or after July 1, 1998.

All other provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged.
