## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

Telecommunications Transmission Facility Committee

For the purpose of temporarily suspending the duties of the Telecommunications Transmission

Facility Committee.

WHEREAS, Section 5A-161 of the Prince George's County Code provides for a Telecommunications Transmission Facility Committee ("the Committee") to serve as a central source of information and provide technical advice on the siting of telecommunications transmission facilities for the County, the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the Board of Education and other public landowners, private landowners, licensed telecommunication carriers, and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is charged with promoting the appropriate and efficient location and co-location of telecommunications transmission facilities to minimize adverse impacts on other land uses in the County, including the evaluation of the aesthetic effects of locating multiple telecommunications transmission facilities in a single location or on a single structure; and

WHEREAS, Section 5A-163(c) of the County Code directs that before approval may be granted to site a telecommunications transmission facility in the County, the Telecommunications Transmission Facility Coordinator shall draft a master plan of actual and proposed telecommunications transmission facilities in the County and submit the master plan to the County Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Committee submitted a report and master plan to the County Council on September 22, 2006; and

1 WHEREAS, Section 5A-163(c) specifies a period of thirty (30) calendar days for Council 2 approval, and that the months of August and December shall not be considered when calculating 3 the thirty (30) day time period; and 4 WHEREAS, there is insufficient time to fully review the recommendations of the 5 Committee prior to the conclusion of the legislative year; and WHEREAS, the Council has expressed concerns with the increased siting of 6 7 telecommunications facilities within residential areas; and 8 WHEREAS, it is anticipated that certain amendments to the Zoning Ordinance may be 9 necessary to implement the recommendations of the revised master plan; and 10 WHEREAS, State law prohibits the Council from enacting amendments to the Zoning Ordinance after October 31 in a year that Councilmanic election year; and 11 WHEREAS, Section 1017 of the County Charter provides that a resolution has the force 12 13 and effect of law but of a temporary or administrative character. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that operations of the Telecommunications Transmission Facility Committee 16 17 be and the same are hereby temporarily suspended pending the completion of the review period 18 by the Council. 19 NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this Resolution shall not apply to, suspend or be 20 interpreted to have any effect on operations of the Telecommunications Transmission Facility 21 Committee related to the review or approval of a site for a telecommunications transmission 22 facility proposed as part of a public safety communications system.
