BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 3-101 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

(31) "Permit" shall mean, when used as a verb, human conduct in relation to an owned animal which is intentional, deliberate, careless, inadvertent or negligent.

(32) "Pet" shall mean a domesticated animal kept for pleasure rather than utility. Pets include, but are not limited to, dogs, cats, birds, fish, reptiles, <u>Chinese Potbellied pigs</u>, and other animals, which, by habit or training, live in association with man.
