AN ACT concerning

Chinese Potbellied Pigs

FOR the purpose of specifying that Chinese Potbellied pigs are considered pets.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 3. ANIMAL CONTROL.

Section 3-101,

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 3-101 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

**SUBTITLE 3. ANIMAL CONTROL.**

**DIVISION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

**Sec. 3-101. Definitions.**

\* \* \* \* \*

(31) "Permit" shall mean, when used as a verb, human conduct in relation to an owned animal which is intentional, deliberate, careless, inadvertent or negligent.

(32) "Pet" shall mean a domesticated animal kept for pleasure rather than utility. Pets include, but are not limited to, dogs, cats, birds, fish, reptiles, Chinese Potbellied pigs, and other animals, which, by habit or training, live in association with man.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
