WHEREAS, the Annu	al Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County	
for Fiscal Year 2008 – 2009	was adopted by CB-28-2008; and	
WHEREAS, Section	817 of the Prince George's County Charter provides that if the	
County Executive shall asco	ertain that the available revenue for the year may be less than the total	
appropriations, he shall reco	onsider the appropriations for all agencies, and may revise them so as	
to forestall expenditures in	excess of the income and fund balances; and	
WHEREAS, there has been a decline in anticipated revenues necessitating a reduction in		
appropriations and expendit	tures; now, therefore,	
SECTION 1. BE IT E	ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, that Chapter 8, The Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland of 2008, being the		
Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for FY 2008-2009 be and the same is hereby		
amended as to revenues and	appropriations as set forth in Exhibits 1 and 2 attached hereto and	
made a part hereof.		
SECTION 2. BE IT F	TURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby	
declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,		

sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
