This enabling bill will provide the authority to borrow \$31,389,000 in aggregate for nineteen school capital projects. There is no immediate fiscal impact on the County from bond enabling bills until the projects are incorporated into a bond authorization bill and the bonds are sold. The projects in this bill are included as part of the aggregate total of \$64.9 million in CB-59-2002. The proportionate share of the debt service for these projects is approximately \$2.4 million annually.
