BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

The proposed legislation will provide for a democratically elected council of non-union employees to meet with management officials to facilitate communications between management and unrepresented employees on work place issues. Currently there is no mechanism for County management to obtain the benefit of the experience of a large and diverse work force prior to establishing policies impacting the delivery of services to customers within the government and outside the government.
