RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Prince George's County Five-Year Transit Development Master Plan. For the purpose of adopting the Prince George's County Five-Year Transit Development Master Plan (TDMP) as the official document to guide the County's implementation and operation of County public transportation services for the next five years.

WHEREAS, the TDMP identifies the County transit demands and needs as defined by those areas which can support bus services but lack sufficient service; and

WHEREAS, the TDMP identifies service improvements for Metrobus service, local bus service and paratransit service based on a comprehensive analysis of existing services, mobility needs, potential transit demand and prior studies; and

WHEREAS, the TDMP is a comprehensive five-year plan providing cost, revenue and funding projections to guide transit services through the Year 2000; and

WHEREAS, the base year of the plan is funded through the Maryland Department of Transportation and the Washington Suburban Transit Commission Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation has funded the implementation of new local bus services for the base year as recommended in the TDMP; and

WHEREAS, the TDMP establishes public transportation goals and policies for operating bus service in the County and service standards for measuring these goals and policies; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Transportation is designated as the County agency responsible for implementation of the TDMP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Five-Year Transit Development Master Plan is adopted.
