PROPOSED AMENDMENT

2 1. On page 4, line 3, and page 4, lines 11-12, and page 4, line 19, and page 5, lines 12-13,
3 strike, in each instance “Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)” and replace with
4 “Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)”
5
- 6 2. On page 4, line 31 through page 5, line 2, strike all text and replace with the following:
7 (2) for apprenticeable trades, only employ workers who:
8 (A) are an apprentice participating in an apprenticeship program registered
9 with the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council;
10 (B) have completed a registered apprenticeship program;
11 (C) have a State-issued occupational license; or
12 (D) are recognized as experienced and competent by an entity approved by the
13 Board.

- 15 3. On page 5, following line 14, add a new subsection (d) as follows:
16 (d) Nothing in this Division shall be construed in a manner that conflicts with federal
17 or State laws, regulations, or conditions of public funding.

- 19 4. On page 5, following line 24, add a new Section 4 as follows:
20 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the amended provisions of Section
21 2-253.01 shall be enforceable one-hundred eighty (180) days after the effective date of
22 this Act, during which time County shall provide guidance to contractors, develop
23 standardized compliance procedures, and conduct outreach regarding the new

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requirements.
