RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

A Review of the Accessibility of County Government Services to the Hispanic Community

For the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Examine County Government Services and their accessibility to the Hispanic Community and to recommend ways of increasing the access of those services.

WHEREAS, the 1998 United States Census Report shows that more than 5% of the County's population is Hispanic and the population has doubled in size over the past ten years; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County has the fourth largest Hispanic community in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area and ranks second in the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, a 1999 report by CASA of Maryland and the Public Justice Center states that Hispanics in the County have problems accessing government services due to language barriers; and

WHEREAS, such barriers to government services may create potential liabilities for some county agencies; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County is desirous of providing equal access to all county residents regardless of their capacity to speak English; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Directors of certain county agencies or their representatives and representatives from Hispanic groups to meet with County officials to determine the number of services readily accessible to Spanish-speaking individuals and to develop an inventory of those services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Task Force is established to Review the Accessibility of County Government Services to the Hispanic Community and to recommend ways of increasing the access of those services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force shall be comprised of fifteen (15) members appointed within thirty (30) days of adoption of this resolution and in the following manner:

- (1) Four members appointed by the Chair of the County Council;
- (2) Four members appointed by the County Executive;
- (3) One representative from the following community organizations: Action Langely Park; CASA of Maryland; Centro Catolico; La Comunidad de Habla Hispana; the Hispanic Resource Center; the Legal Aid Bureau; and the Law Foundation;
- Task Force:
 Office of Business and Regulatory Affairs; Department of Environmental Resources;
 Department of Family Services; Fire/EMS Department; Department of Health;
 Department of Housing and Community Development; Police Department; Sheriff's Department; Department of Social Services; Office of the State's Attorney; the

(4) County agencies shall have non-voting representatives to assist the members of the

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council shall direct appropriate staff to assist and advise the members of the Task Force in its efforts as necessary.

Human Relations Commission; and other agencies as necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force Report to the County Council shall contain a list of accessible services currently provided by the County and a prioritized list of services which the County should provide and an estimated cost for those services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force Report to the County Council shall be used as a model by the County to enhance the services provided to other non-English speaking residents of Prince George's County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of the Task Force Report to the County Council shall be prepared in Spanish or other languages as deemed necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Task Force on the Review of the Accessibility of County Government Services to the Hispanic Community shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the County Council within 120 calendar days from the adoption of this resolution.
