**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT****(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

The State of Maryland requires a resolution by the County Council for each Community Legacy Program application for unincorporated areas. If this application is approved by the State, the International Corridor community will be designated as a "Community Legacy Area" and will receive funding in the amount of \$200,000 for preparation of a comprehensive revitalization plan, which is required for future implementation funding through the Community Legacy Program.
