WHEREAS, the U	se and Occupancy – No Construction, New Tenant or Owner Change –	
Commercial permit fee	for a change in use shall be paid by the property owner; and	
WHEREAS, this policy change should incentivize small businesses to open, operate, and		
remain in the County, and help overall in economic development and building our commercial		

tax base;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-253.63 of the Prince George's County Code, the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement ("DPIE") shall establish and maintain a table of fees for all types of permits and such table shall be published on the DPIE website; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-253.63 of the Prince George's County Code, the Director of DPIE or the County Council shall have the authority to change the fees, which includes a change in the payor of the Use and Occupancy – No Construction, New Tenant or Owner Change - Commercial permit fee as deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, prior to changing the fees, and also, in changing payors of said fees, DPIE must hold a public information session to allow for public comment, must submit the fee changes

to the County Executive for approval, and then must submit the fee changes to County Council by Resolution for approval after notice and a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Attachment A is the proposed addition to the Table of Fees, Section 2-253.63, and as published on the DPIE website, Use and Occupancy – No Construction, New Tenant or Owner Change – Commercial permit fee, attached hereto and made a part of the record hereof; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive reviewed such changes and approved the payor assignments as appropriate and necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Use and Occupancy – No Construction, New Tenant or Owner Change – Commercial permit fee payor assignments set forth in this Resolution be adopted and maintained by Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement as described in the Table of Fees set forth in Attachment A, attached hereto and made a part of the record hereof, is approved as appropriate and necessary.
